- 9) Refrain from the use of alcohol, tobacco, illegal and non-prescription drugs, anabolic steroids or any substance to increase physical development or performance that is not approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration, Surgeon General of the United States or American Medical Association.
- 10) Know and follow all state, section and school athletic rules and regulations as they pertain to eligibility and sports participation.
- 11) Win with character, lose with dignity.

Financial Contract

They help pay for the teams' travel expenses, CIF fees, league fees, equipment, uniforms, and referees fees. This year we are really trying to promote academics to our student athletes. We will be rewarding student high academic achievement by lowering varsity dues to student athletes with good grades in the previous semester.

Here is the breakdown:

\$275 varsity dues if GPA is below a 3.0

\$225 varsity dues if GPA is between 3.1 - 3.5

\$200 varsity dues if GPA is between 3.6 - 4.0

\$150 varsity dues if GPA is higher than 4.0
