Dear Parents and 5th Grade Students,

Below is your School Supply List for 5th Grade. You must have all your supplies by Wednesday, August 24.

- ___ 1 Backpack/Book Bag
- ___ 1 Box of Crayons
- ___ 1 Box of Colored Pencils
- ___ 1 Box of Colored Markers
- ___ 1 Small Scissors (with your name written on them)
- ___ 2 Packages of No. 2 Lead Pencils (or No. 2 Mechanical Pencils)
- ___ 1 Pencil Sharpener with lid or cover to hold shavings (only if bringing No. 2 Lead Pencils)
- ___ 1 Packages of Blue or Black Erasable Pens
- ___ 1 Package of NON-Erasable Colored Pens (for correcting)
- ___ 1 Set of 4 Fine Tip Dry-Erase Markers in assorted colors
- ___ 3-ring College-Ruled Notebook Paper (must have a continuous supply at school at all times)
- ___ 1 Memory Stick (USB memory stick 2GB or higher)
- ___ 1 Large Box of Kleenex
- ___ 1 Liquid Glue Bottle
- ___ 3 Glue Sticks
- ___ 3 Large Containers of Disinfecting Cleaning Wipes
- ___ Children's International Bible (if you have one – otherwise one will be provided at school)
- ___ \$20 (cost includes misc. school & art supplies, a container to hold supplies, STAR folder and science lab supplies)
- ___ Optional – 55cm Exercise Ball (You can purchase this at Target or Walmart for under \$20).
Student will be able to use this in place of a hard chair.

Please Do Not Bring the Following: correction fluid, permanent ballpoint pens, calculators, or compasses.

Students will receive their STAR folders the first day of school. No other folder is necessary.

Parents, as many of you already know, the 5th and 6th grade classes get the opportunity to go to Astro Camp in Idyllwild, CA. It is something that the students have been looking forward to and is such a memorable experience - a great educational field trip! Unfortunately, Astro Camp only allows one adult per 15 children. We always push for one more adult in case of emergency and for transportation purposes. So, we are in need of one male Chaperone from both 5th and 6th grades.
