The following list contains all of the supplies your child will need to be successful this school year. Please read the following carefully:

Highly recommended: 1 personal tablet/laptop that they are able to bring on a daily basis. If they are not able to bring one, we will assign a school chrome book that they can use for the year. However, chrome books are very limited, so if possible a personal tablet/laptop is preferred.

- 1 Heavy-Duty 2-inch binder with pockets in the front and back
- 5 **COLLEGE RULED** composition notebooks (for language arts, science, math, social studies and Bible)
- 1 package of 3-hole **COLLEGE-RULED** loose-leaf paper **in binder** (must be replenished by student throughout the year)
- 1 package of 5-tab plastic dividers **with pockets**
- 1 pencil pouch
- 1 combination lock for P.E. locker (**Jr. High Only**)

Students must have the following items in their pencil pouch **every single day of class**. Please purchase enough of each item so that students can replenish their pencil pouches as needed.

- At least 5 mechanical pencils with extra lead (**Mechanical pencils only please! We are implementing sharpener-free UE classrooms.**)
- 1 eraser
- 1 black/blue pen and 1 red pen
- 1 highlighter (any color)
- 1 pair of scissors that fits into pencil pouch
- 1 glue stick

- 1 expo marker eraser or cloth
